We are Refreshed

- **Exodus 24:9-11;** ⁹ Then Moses went up with Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, ¹⁰ and **they saw the God of Israel;** and under **His feet there appeared to be a pavement of sapphire**, as clear as the sky itself (Rev 4:6 – **Sea of Glass**). ¹¹ Yet He did not stretch out His hand against the nobles of the sons of Israel; and **they saw God, and they ate and drank.**

We receive Revelation

- Rev 4:1 After these things I looked, and behold, **a door standing open in heaven**, and the first voice which I had heard, like the **sound of a trumpet** speaking with me, said, “**Come up here**, and **I will show** you what must take place after these things.”

We are Refined

- Exodus 20:18-21; ¹⁸ All the people perceived the **thunder** and the **lightning flashes** and the **sound of the trumpet** and **the mountain smoking**; and when the **people saw it**, they trembled and stood at a distance.
- ¹⁹ Then they said to Moses, “Speak to us yourself and we will listen; but let not God speak to us, **or we will die.**”
- ²⁰ Moses said to the people, “Do not be afraid; for God has come in order to **test you**, and **in order that the fear of Him may remain with you, so that you may not sin.**”
- ²¹ So the people **stood at a distance**, while Moses **approached the thick cloud where God was.**

We are Refined

- Isaiah 6 ⁵ Then I said, “Woe is me, for I am ruined! Because I am a man of **unclean lips**, And I live among a people of unclean lips; **For my eyes have seen the King**, the Lord of hosts.” ⁶ Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a **burning coal** in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs. ⁷ **He touched my mouth** with it and said, “Behold, this has touched your lips; and **your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven.**”
- Without refinement in Character we cannot sustain what God wants to put on us – His anointing. Refinement creates a foundation that won’t crack under the weight of the anointing.
